"Living In Christ"

Colossians 3:1-17

We've been discussing at some length what it means to be "in Christ." Today: How do I remain in Christ? (John 15:4)

Typical of Paul's Communication Strategy: 1st Half Doctrine, 2nd Half Practice.

Ask yourself these questions daily:

- 1. Where's my focus? (i.e, Where do I look?) (1-4)
 - A. "If you have been raised up with Christ" to a new life. (Col. 2:10-13)
 - I. Your position now is with Him in Heaven. (Eph. 2:1-2, 4-6)
 - B. Notice: We have to "keep seeking" & "set our minds". It's a full-time job.
 - I. Bible Study, Prayer, Worship, Fellowship.
 - II. Watch out that you don't drift (i.e, slow movement away from these).

2. Am I killing the sin in my life? (to my old self and sinful ways). (5-9)

- A. If so, I should be doing these things less and less.
- B. "Consider" "put to death" in the Greek.
 - I. It's a verb; I have to do this with the Holy Spirit's help.
 - II. Do violence to your flesh (spiritually).
 - a.) Crucify it!
- C. The top catagories of sin: (or, "Idolatry" vs. 5)

I.	Immorality (fornication).
II.	Impurity (akatharsia) - "uncleanness"
III.	Passion (pathos) - "the condition of your sin-diseased soul"
IV.	Evil Desire (epithumia) - "your sin-diseased soul in action"
V.	Greed (covetousness) - usually associated with the love of money.
VI.	Anger - It's internal; a state of mind.
VII.	Wrath - It's external; anger manifested.
VIII.	Malice - Doing evil to others.
VIIII.	Slander - Speaking evil of others.
Χ.	Abusive Speech - "foul-mouthed" "filthy" "improper"
XI.	Lying - speaking the opposite of truth (Satan's native language).

All of this is what I'm dying to. Now, what am I living for?

3. Am I putting on Christ daily? (10-17) see 2 Cor. 5:17

- A. "Renewed" "to make new" "according to the image of Christ."
 - I. It's actually past tense in the Greek. So, it's already happened.
 - II. My part is to come in line with who I am in Christ each day.
- B. What living in Christ looks like:
 - I. Compassion pity or empathy for those who suffer.
 - II. Kindness a mellowing of your personality leading to the opposite of harshness and severity. This will be useful rather than harmful to those around you.
 - III. Humility Lowliness of mind; absolute dependance.
 - IV. Gentleness (meekness) a condition of mind and heart which demonstrates gentleness, not weakness, but in power. It's being weak even when you could demonstrate strength.
 - V. Patience: (long-suffering) "self-restraint before proceeding to action. The quality of being able to avenge yourself but refraining from doing so.

VI.	Bearing with others & Forgiving- "hold up" towards others' irritations and release them from any wrong they've caused you.
VII.	Love
VIII.	Peace - at the back of peace is "oneness".
VIIII.	The Word - Hebrews 4:12
Χ.	Do all in Jesus' Name - Your faith ought to be public.
XI.	Give Thanks - 1 Thessalonians 5:18
